WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO STUDY

APTC is open to citizens from:



APTC courses are for people who:

- Have significant prior industry experience (more than one year) in the area in which they wish to train; or
- Have a local qualification and limited relevant industry experience (up to one year) in the area in which they wish to train.

Eligibility and selection varies for different programs. Applicants are required to undertake the following assessments:

- Language, literacy and numeracy
- Vocational knowledge in the relevant industry

These assessments are designed to ensure applicants have the necessary skills and knowledge to successfully complete the course.

HOW MUCH WILL IT COST

All Pacific Islanders are eligible to apply for a limited number of partial or full scholarships. These scholarships are provided by the Australian Government to promote access and equity for Pacific Islanders. The scholarships are targeted towards individuals from rural and remote areas, small island states, people with a disability, men and women in non-traditional trades.

Fee paying places are also available. Fees vary according to the program, course duration and location of delivery. Fees are heavily subsidised by the Australian Government.
