6.1 Fiji

SUMMARY

Campus Highlights

APTC Cookery and Hospitality Staff met with well-known New Zealand Chef, Robert Oliver. Robert was interested to hear the trainers discuss the selection of local ingredients used at Fusion, the APTC training restaurant. Robert will soon commence writing a recipe book on Fiji cuisine, cultural dishes and ingredients propagated in Fiji. APTC Cookery Students had the opportunity to listen to Robert's cookery journey which commenced as a scholar at Suva Grammar.

Education and Training Delivery

The recently commenced Kiribati Institute of Technology (KIT) automotive group are part of the APTC/KIT partnership. The group completed the Australian Certificate II in Automotive (TAFESA) at KIT and will complete training in the AUR30612 Certificate III in Light Vehicle Mechanical Technology qualification at APTC.

All STT classes this semester are completing their final blocks. Trainers, tutors and training assistants are working with students to successfully complete their qualifications. The training schedule for STT will move to a one-semester model from 1 July 2015.

The Home and Community Care/Aged Care program has been relaunched in Fiji this semester. Outcomes to date have been very positive.

Students across SHCS programs have commenced their work placements. The students, trainers, tutors and support staff worked diligently to get everyone suitably placed. Facilities utilised include Home of Compassion, Father Law Homes, and Sambula Aged Care facility.

Stakeholder Engagement: DFAT, Industry and Community

Industry engagement through work placement visits by trainers/tutors will continue in SHCS this semester. Trainers have joined relevant Suva Industry Associations to expand the knowledge of local industry needs.

The STT Country Manager attended the Fiji Master Builders Association (FMBA) meeting and met with representatives from the industry. The FMBA annual general meeting is planned for later this semester. Participation in these events support the improved alignment of the APTC training profile with industry needs.

Training delivery for the European Union's "Accompanying Measures for Sugar Protocol (AMSP – 2013) – Strategic Restructuring of the Sugar Cane Industry" program has commenced. The training is aligned to the industry training needs analysis conducted at the commencement of the program.

DFAT Solomon Islands made a request to APTC to identify students suitable for entry into the Hospitality Industry Mobility Worker program. APTC Alumni are assisting with the provision of this information.

The Solomon Islands Country Manager continues to attend the monthly meetings of the Solomon Islands Chamber of Commerce. The Manager Quality, Performance and Research and the Country Manager were invited to participate in the recent Ministry of Education and Human Resources Development 2015 Tertiary Education Think Tank. The purpose of the Think Tank was for government representatives and training providers to discuss delivery offerings and strategies for the Solomon Islands institutions.

Facilities, ICT, Assets: Accommodation, Security Equipment and Buildings

APTC recently installed two wastewater treatment plants at the Don Bosco site. These units will be connected to two ablution blocks this semester.

Construction of the Skills Barn located on the Don Bosco site, funded through APTC, has been completed.
